



CORONA GUIDELINES

FOR VISITORS



TICKETING

By issuing online tickets only, we can also maintain an overview of visitor numbers at all times. But we unfortunately cannot offer some types of tickets for 2021.



PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Due to the comprehensive visitor registration measures in place, we are unable to offer any combo tickets for ferry or catamaran. BODO combi tickets will still be available. Furthermore, the Messe-Express (line MX) as usual connects the city station/port station and the fairgrounds free of charge.



MINIMUM DISTANCING

All visitors are requested to observe minimum distance of 1.5 metres.

FULL REGISTRATION

All visitors have to register online in advance. This ensures traceability in the event of a coronavirus infection. For this reason, in 2021 there will only be online tickets.

PARKING

As entry tickets, parking tickets are also only available for purchase online.

MOUTH AND NOSE COVER

Please bring your own mouth and nose cover. Masks have to be worn in enclosed spaces at the exhibition centre!

Exceptions:

- Seating with guaranteed minimum spacing of 1.5 metres.
- While eating / drinking.
- On trade fair stands where individuals can observe minimum social distancing of 1.5 metres.
- Where alternative protection for others of at least an equal standard is assured.
- Mask intolerance confirmed by a doctor's certificate. Otherwise you have to wear a corona protection visor.

The provisions that currently apply are shown in the Messe Friedrichshafen's Protection and Hygiene Concept.

HYGIENE

Hand sanitiser have to be provided at each stand. Surfaces must be cleaned regularly. Furthermore please refrain customary greeting rituals, and observe sneezing and coughing etiquette. You will find an adequate number of hand sanitiser dispensers throughout the exhibition centre, most notably at the entrances, hall intersections and the WC areas. The disinfection and cleaning intervals for stark used surfaces such as doorknobs and handholds as well as sanitary areas are increased accordingly.

INCREASED SPACE

We have increased hallway, traffic and activity spaces. By doing this we are giving visitors and exhibitors greater freedom of movement while guaranteeing the required distancing.

VENTILATION

Entrance areas, exhibition halls, conference rooms and dining areas will be permanently supplied with fresh air (outdoor air quality).

SUPPORTING PROGRAMME

In 2021 there will once again be a extensive supporting programme with action shows and test parcours. However there will be limited access to the stuntshows.

ENTRY AND PARTICIPATION BAN

Persons who are in contact with a person infected with the Coronavirus, or have been in contact with a person infected with the Coronavirus, or who present the typical symptoms of a Coronavirus infection are not allowed to enter the exhibition grounds.
